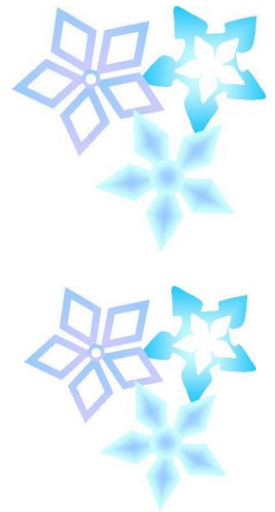

Lois worked as a school secretary at a variety of Green Bay elementary schools for over 30 years.

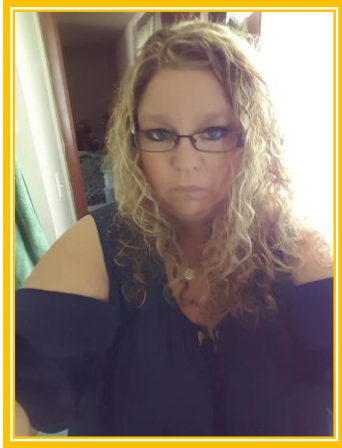
Two of her favorite past hobbies were downhill skiing and water skiing. Some of her current hobbies are praying the rosary and playing dice games.
