Her favorite meal is salmon with buttered noodles and a glass of red wine.

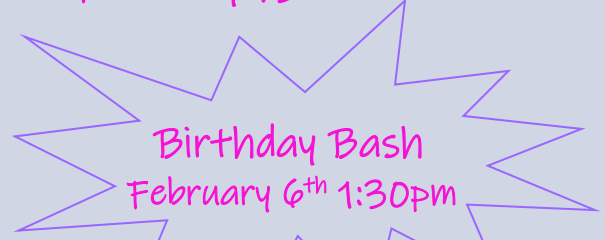
Brinna's favorite time of year is summer because it is warmer and there is a lot more to do.
