

COVID-19 Update:

Our goal is to keep all of our residents and staff safe. If at any time a resident does not follow the guidelines set up by the public health department, CDC and the facility, they may be quarantined to their room for up to 14 days for the safety of themselves and others.

In effort to continue to provide the safest environment for our residents;

We will remain in Phase 2 until further notice. Phase 2 includes:

- Allowing Limited Outside Family Visits
 - Family must wear and provide their own mask
 - Must remain 6 feet apart from resident
 - Each resident is allowed to have 4 visitors at a time
 - Visits must take place in designated areas only
- Allowing limited family visits in family room, only if resident is physically unable to visit outside- which will be approved by the director
 - Anyone entering the facility must sign in, wash their hands with soap and water, wear mask, log temperature and complete symptom questionnaire
 - Must remain 6 feet apart from resident
 - Each resident is allowed to have up to 2 visitors at one time
 - Maximum visit time of 45 minutes
 - Must call the facility Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. to schedule visit time in order to regulate the number of people at the facility at one time.
- Families may take resident out of the facility for a car ride, including church or to dine out.
 - We are highly encouraging resident to wear a mask when leaving the facility and use proper hand hygiene
 - You do not need to schedule an appointment for a car drive, but we ask for you to notify staff in advance so we are aware the resident is leaving
 - Though we are unable to control what happens while a resident is out of the facility, we ask for everyone to be mindful of their actions and any places they may stop. Understand the potential risk of exposure associated when in a social setting

Voting

The last day for electors to register by mail or online to vote for the General Election is 5:00 pm on October 14th.

Any resident who is not registered and wishes to vote absentee in the General Election can fill out and mail a registration application and absentee ballot request available through life enrichment. A resident must be in the facility ninety days in order to vote at that address.

Persons who are placed under guardianship pursuant to court order under ch.880, Stats., or are found incapable of understanding the electoral process are not permitted to vote.

When the ballots arrive late October via USPS; either the residents can fill them out on their own, a member of the Life Enrichment staff will assist, or a family member may assist them.

Reminder to families and residents;

There is a \$6 room tray fee per meal for any resident who declines to eat in the dining room and requests a meal in their room.

Exceptions to this include:

- Any resident on hospice -nearing the end of life
- > Residents quarantined to their room
- Residents with a physician's order.





Creamy Pumpkin Soup

Ingredients:

- 1 cup chicken broth
- 1/4 Greek yogurt
- 1 (15-ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 teaspoon minced fresh garlic
- 1/4 cup chopped onion
- 1 tablespoon honey
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Heavy cream for garnish (optional)

Directions:

1. Place all ingredients in a large saucepan over medium-high

heat. Bring to a boil. Once soup has come to a boil, lower the

temperature to medium-low. Allow soup to cook 15–20 minutes,

stirring every so often.

2. Divide into serving bowls and optionally garnish each with a little heavy cream.
