RECIPE OF THE MONTH

SCHAUM STRAWBERRY TORTE

German meringue dessert widely known to Milwaukee residents of German descent.

- 8 Large egg whites
- 1 tablespoon white vinegar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 2 Cups sugar
- 3 Cups sliced, fresh strawberries
- 1-1/2 Cup Whipped cream



Place egg whites in a large bowl and let stand at room temperature for 30 minutes.

Preheat oven to 300 degrees.

Add vinegar, vanilla, and salt to egg whites.

Beat on medium speed until soft peaks form.

Gradually beat in sugar (about 2 tbs at a time) on high until stiff, glossy peals form and sugar is dissolved

Spread into a greased 10-in springform pan. Bake for 50-60 minutes.
