### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

#### CRAB PHYLLO CUPS

If you are out of crab, try them with water-packed tuna.

- ✓ ½ cup reduced-fat spreadable garden vegetable cream cheese
- ✓ ½ tsp seafood seasoning
- ✓ ¾ cub lump crabmeat, drained
- ✓ 2 packages (1.9 oz each) frozen, miniature phyllo tart shells
- ✓ 5 tbs chili sauce

In a small bowl, mix cream cheese and seafood seasoning; gently stir in crab. Spoon two teaspoons crab mixture into each tart shell. Top with chili sauce. Yield: 2-1/2 dozen.
