VANILLA PECAN COOKIES

Ingredients

1-1/4 cups rolled oats
1/2 cup brown sugar
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 cup finely chopped pecans
1/8 teaspoon salt
1/3 cup butter, melted
1 egg, beaten
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions

Preheat oven to 350*. Line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Combine oats, sugar, baking powder, pecans, and salt in a large bowl. Stir in butter, egg, and vanilla. Drop by tablespoonful onto the prepared baking sheet. Bake 8-12 minutes until edges are just golden. Allow cookies to cool slightly before transferring to a cooling rack.
